Honda India Foundation, in its short journey, has extended support to over 65 lakh beneficiaries across India and has undertaken focused corporate social responsibility initiatives in the areas of road safety, environment protection, education and healthcare.

Dear Readers,

It is my privilege to present Honda India Foundation's second Annual CSR Report. It highlights our efforts to support the communities within which we operate and our progress in becoming a more responsible corporate citizen by driving social equity and sustainable development.

Following the spirit of co-existence, the Foundation's approach for CSR has always been **implementing high-impact CSR programmes around the areas of our operations**. This way, we channel substantial commitments towards more sustainable and meaningful impact in the society. **In the past year, we undertook programmes across 05 thematic areas, including road safety, COVID-19 relief, healthcare, environment and education**. These were implemented around the company's areas of operations in the states of **Haryana, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, and Gujarat**.

We continued our efforts to support **COVID-19 relief** efforts by aiding those in need, including daily wage earners, migrants and those who lost their livelihood. Moreover, HIF also distributed PPE kits and sanitizers to front-line workers and provided medical equipment like oxygen concentrators, pulse oximeters etc. in several government hospitals.

Healthcare continued to be a major area of focus for us. We organised specialised healthcare initiatives for women across several states and worked towards improving access to quality healthcare through Mobile Medical Units and Static Medical Units. We also organised free health camps in rural areas of Haryana and Rajasthan and eye check-up camps in Haryana.

In the domain of **education, we worked towards improving access to quality education** through our programme "Honda Ki Pathshala" which addresses the inequity in access to education and has impacted over 200 children. We have also adopted schools in Tapukara, Rajasthan and Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh for infrastructural upgradation. Further, for skill development our Hospitality Management programme is providing employment linked training to underprivileged youth of North-East and has trained and placed over 400 students.

With our global slogan of "Safety for Everyone", **strengthening road safety remained a priority**. We have taken a 360-degree approach for our long-term road safety initiatives comprising of four key areas of work – engineering, enforcement, education, and emergency. As a part of our initiatives, we have set up Institute of Driving and Traffic Research in Karnal which aims to train drivers and build awareness on good road safety practices. In addition to this, we deliver high-quality road safety training and awareness programmes across the country.

Our worldwide **environmental slogan is 'Blue Skies for Our Children'** and our initiatives in this sphere included development and maintenance of green areas in Noida and Manesar, water conservation through SHGs in remote areas of Alwar, Rajasthan, implementation of garbage management system in rural areas, among others.

In its future endeavours Honda India Foundation will **continue its work towards tackling global challenges** like climate change and waste disposal and national and regional challenges of rising road accidents and lack of access to clean drinking water. We believe we have a responsibility to apply our innovation and influence to accelerate towards a sustainable future.



National Footprint & Impact


HIF's social contribution activities are tailored to local circumstances in accordance with its Global Policy for Social Contribution Activities, with the aim of creating future societies in which everyone can pursue their dreams.

Our CSR projects are largely located in geographies around the areas of our operation. HIF implements its CSR projects in the states of **Rajasthan, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Gujarat, and Karnataka** in India and has impacted over **80 lakh people** with its CSR initiatives so far.



CSR Spend 2021-2022

In the Financial Year 2021-22, Honda India Foundation spent **38% of its total disbursed funds on Road Safety initiatives**, led by establishment of **IDTR Karnal** and other road safety awareness activities. **35%** of its funds were spent on **healthcare initiatives including COVID-19** relief support, health camps and MMUs. **27%** of funds were spent on education and employability initiatives, environmental initiatives and other initiatives like rural development.



COVID-19 Initiatives

Since the onset of the pandemic in 2020, HIF has been responding to the crisis nationally, supporting needs of the local communities where we live and work. This year, we have continued our efforts towards COVID-19 support & relief measures in 5 states of Haryana, Rajasthan, Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh and Gujarat.

During the devastating second wave last year, an urgent need was felt for coordinated efforts on several fronts - the government, the social sector and private partners. HIF consolidated its strength and prioritised COVID-19 relief efforts, extending help to overburdened hospitals and medical staff- in collaboration with state governments, NGOs and other implementation partners.

To support growing healthcare needs, we setup isolation centres, and oxygen plants in hospitals along with providing them with necessary medical equipment like oxygen concentrators, pulse oximeters, etc. We also equipped front-line workers and healthcare professionals with PPE kits, masks, sanitizers.



Expanding Rural India's Quarantine Capacity

The COVID-19 pandemic in India increased the burden on many healthcare systems and in the process, exposed the need for medical resources and physical space. **Thus, to maximize health care service capacity during the pandemic, especially in rural areas, HIF facilitated set up of COVID isolation centers in collaboration with Spherule Foundation.**

Focussed on medical support and care for patients in rural areas, **Isolation centers were set-up in Naurangpur, Haryana and Tapukara, Rajasthan** with a capacity of 100 and 50 beds respectively. The two facilities, set-up in association with Haryana and Rajasthan state governments, have round the clock supervision by trained doctors and nurses along with other medical arrangements.

Boosting Oxygen Capacity

India faced an acute shortage of **oxygen** during the **2nd wave of COVID-19** pandemic earlier last year as cases began to surge. To offer meaningful assistance to most affected cities and states, **HIF** deployed its resources and channelled efforts that provided **relief during extenuating circumstances**. We organised resources on war footing and helped in abating the **oxygen crisis in government hospitals in Haryana and Karnataka**.

Protecting COVID-19 Front-Line Heroes

Amid increasing global shortage of protected gear, HIF swung into action and reached out to an array of **front-line workers** – from hospital staff to **ASHA workers** and provided them with **PPE kits, masks and sanitisers**. The objective was to help them carry out their role of providing **essential services** to the community in a manner that ensured their **personal safety**.





Healthcare Initiatives

Honda India Foundation is committed to 'Quality Healthcare for All'. This mission has propelled efforts at building and strengthening healthcare in the country. Since inception, **HIF has taken efforts to support health outreach and infrastructure towards better public health and quality medical services for rural and marginalized communities.**

This year, diverse and specialized healthcare programs have been undertaken to strengthen access to quality healthcare facilities with **projects like free of cost healthcare centres, eye camps and mobile medical units** and also support various government initiatives on reproductive and maternal health with **Swabhiman**, a specialized healthcare initiative for women. Championing the United Nations SDGs, HIF also strives to generate awareness and make health services more accessible in order to improve the lives of millions of people.



Swabhiman: Specialized Health Initiative for women

Healthcare seeking behavior is defined as any action or inaction undertaken by individuals who perceive themselves to have a health problem. It is essential to encourage health seeking behavior in order to provide basic healthcare services and develop strategies for improving utilization of health services particularly by women.

The health of women is particularly important since many socio-cultural factors prevent women to benefit from quality health services. To end this, **HIF undertook a specialized health initiative with the objective of strengthening existing healthcare infrastructure with a focus on women's health.** It focused on awareness generation for behavior change and attitude shift in women & adolescent girls. It also **developed 'Change Agents'** in community who could continue to build on the activities to promote behavior change.

Objectives



- To generate awareness on the issues of reproductive & sexual health including child health, family planning, RTI/STI, HIV among adolescent girls and young married women

- To improve health seeking behavior in women with respect to reproductive and sexual health issues

- To sensitize adolescent girls on gender issues through Life Skill Education

- To build confidence and assertiveness in young women to challenge the gender stereotypes to improve their health and social status

The initiative was undertaken in **collaboration with local government authorities** and promoted government schemes like **National Health Mission**. It addressed important issues like anemia, nutrition, family planning, immunization, menstrual hygiene.

Strengthening public health through free of cost health camps

Primary health care is the cornerstone of an equitable and resilient healthcare system. **HIF's health camps initiative is aimed at providing preventive and primary healthcare to underprivileged families.** During the year, many health consultations were provided across locations including Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh and Tapukara, Rajasthan.

These camps are set up for providing medical services and raising awareness about preventive healthcare.

Healthcare on Wheels

India consistently ranks low globally in access and quality of healthcare. Lack of quality infrastructure, dearth of qualified medical functionaries, and access to basic medicines and medical facilities are especially pronounced in India's rural areas.

Realizing the critical need of rural population for primary healthcare, HIF launched Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) and Static Medical Units (SMUs) in the states of Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Karnataka in 2018.

Currently, 5 MMUs and 1 SMU operates across these four states providing primary, preventive, diagnostic, and referral health services at the doorstep of people in remote areas. The MMUs and SMUs are equipped with state-of-the-art diagnostic facilities and accompanied by a dedicated medical team consisting of a doctor, a nurse, a pharmacist and a social protection officer.

These units provide services throughout the year, which aid rural communities in availing healthcare facilities at their doorsteps, thereby

To make people's life colorful, **Deepalaya Honda Eye Vision Centre was established in Gusbethi, Mewat and Sohna village in Haryana.** The centre run in collaboration with Deepalaya and AIIMS, provides free eye check-up for public in rural areas, promotes & educates people on eye health screens and diagnosis of eye diseases.

Community based RO plants for safe and clean drinking water

A safe water supply is the backbone of a healthy economy. Studies have shown that clean drinking water is associated with reduced rates of mortality, further, numerous water borne diseases such as cholera, typhoid, and dysentery are spread by unclean water. Clean water can help reduce the spread of these diseases, which has a positive impact on the health of the individual and the community.

To help solve this issue, **RO plants were installed across various locations in Karnataka including drought hit district of Kolar.** Kolar has faced severe droughts in the past few decades. All water bodies on the surface have been dried up and underground water, the only water source has reduced up to 1,300-1,500 feet depth. Water in such lower levels is not fit for drinking without treatment and cause chronic health impacts. In such circumstances, access to clean drinking water is imperative and the RO Plants help alleviate these issues.



Education & Employability Initiatives

Honda India Foundation has a **targeted approach to its education interventions, going beyond providing academic support** to focus on bridging gaps in the **holistic development of disadvantaged students** at different levels of education. Its targeted approach, with interventions at each stage of academic development has **improved the scholastic performance of students and increased their confidence.**

Equitable access to quality education is championed by filling the resource gap via academic and financial support to students from disadvantaged sections of society. HIF's targeted approach includes adopting schools and upskilling the teachers and improving the infrastructure by setting up STEM and digital classrooms. Further, initiatives like **Honda ki Pathshaala** provides after school support to students and has infused confidence in children from disadvantaged communities.

Besides academic education, HIF also supports vocational education through skill development initiatives like providing training to students from North-East India and training to medical workers during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Honda India Foundation is working to improve the quality of education in its adopted schools in Greater Noida, Budibawal & Tapukara. Besides traditional models of education, interactive, innovative and easily comprehensible teaching methods have been introduced along with dedicated programs to upskill teachers.

Special emphasis has been given to computer classes, sports, extra-curricular activities, value education & promoting their leadership skills in these schools.

The initiative aims that with better infrastructure, upgraded teaching methods and amenities a behavioural change, will **lead to improved learning outcomes and strengthen the employability of students** to drive long term positive societal impact.


Skilling the youth of North-East India

India currently faces a dual challenge of **shortage of well-trained, skilled workers** on one hand and **non-employability of graduates**, who possess little or no job-oriented skills on the other hand. Government of India has launched several schemes to bridge this gap. However, **provision of equitable access to such schemes remains a challenge.**

This is especially true for India's North-east

region, where access to skill development resources is limited. Further, insurgency and political instability in various North-Eastern regions exacerbates issues faced by job seekers.

HIF joined hands with Visan Foundation to **implement a skill development program for the youth from North-East India.** This program provides training in 'Hospitality Management' and has trained **390 students** so far.




The course 'Hospitality Management' was chosen due to the following reasons:




Honda India Foundation partnered with NGO KHUSHI to **address the inequity in access to education through the project “Honda Pathshala”**, in 5 villages in Manesar, Haryana. The goal of the project was to **provide continued education to the students who did not have access to digital platforms** for learning during school closures due to COVID-19 lockdown. The teaching in these Pathshalas have continued even after re-opening of schools.



Project Objectives

- Reducing Education Inequity:** To address the inequity in academic engagement and achievement for students with limited/no device access.
- Improvement in Learning Levels:** To help students by bridging learning gaps that may have developed during lockdown through establishment of 5 Learning Hubs
- Reducing dropouts:** To empower at-risk students to stay in school, with priority placement at broadcast centres for continued engagement with academics

Project Shakti: Skilling Healthcare Professionals

The General Duty Assistant or GDA program is **designed to provide quality care to patients admitted in nursing homes and hospitals.** Project Shakti of HIF designed to develop skills of healthcare professionals, in 'General Duty Assistance' has a **long-term vision to create a force of medical support staff/ front line warriors in India.**

The magnitude of crisis during the pandemic in 2021 and surge in number of cases led to immediate requirement of skilled workforce to

meet the increasing demand for healthcare professionals. Under the program, the **trainees are provided GDA program training in various hospitals.** Responsibilities of a General Duty Assistant are to provide patient's daily care, patient's comfort, their safety and their health needs. On successful completion of the General Duty Assistant course, the students have a plethora of career options to choose from and can progress by taking more responsibilities.

Under this initiative **HIF provides 100% scholarship to deserving young women** from the states of Gujarat, Haryana & Rajasthan in

becoming **commercial pilots**. The initiative **supports the selected young women in the entire lifecycle of training** right from their selection to a training period of 36 months in one of India's leading flying schools and later in getting jobs as commercial pilots.

Successful students receive a **graduate degree in BSc Civil Aviation and a Commercial Pilot License from DGCA**.







Development of Green Areas

Green areas and open spaces improve our physical and psychological health, strengthen our communities, and make our cities and neighborhoods more attractive places to live and work. However, few people can enjoy these benefits, especially in metropolitan cities. Hence, HIF has developed and **maintains green stretches in Greater Noida, Uttar Pradesh and Manesar, Haryana.**

HIF is maintaining a **stretch of 6 Kms of green area from Pari Chowk to Madhiya Chowk in Greater Noida** in partnership with Greater Noida Industrial Development Authority (GNIDA). HIF is also **maintaining a 3 Km stretch of road from IMT chowk to Denso cut in Manesar, Haryana.**







Sustainable water management

Under Honda's global **environmental motto of "Blue Skies for Our Children"**, HIF works with local communities to recharge groundwater reservoirs and ensure sustainable water solutions. For this project HIF partnered with local partner, Society for Public Education Cultural Training and Rural Action (SPECTRA) a voluntary, non-profit and non-government organization with over 24 years of experience of carrying out projects of such nature.

In the project, **local SHGs are provided with basic and technical trainings to become 'water leaders'** and construct structures for water conservation. **A range of water harvesting structures are encouraged—farm ponds, earthen dams, johads, anicuts—as per the topography, soil quality and availability of materials.**

The objective of the project is sustainable water resource management and restoration of water resources which should help improve productivity and recharge groundwater. It is understood that this would in turn help **empower local communities & SHG members** and other marginalized members of the society.






Road Safety Awareness Through SDECs and Traffic Training Parks

Road Safety Initiatives

Honda has adopted **"Safety for Everyone"** as its global safety slogan. This is done to further the Honda Environmental and Safety Vision comprised of **"Realizing the joy and freedom of mobility and a sustainable society where people can enjoy life"**. HIF is working towards realizing "a mobile society with zero collisions" through safe coexistence.

Moreover, road safety is a national concern and HIF is committed towards building a collision-free mobile society. HIF follows the **3Es approach of: Engineering, Enforcement and Education into one framework to maximize key resources**. With respect to Engineering, HIF has upgraded infrastructure across major Highways and roads in Haryana and Rajasthan; in Enforcement, Police Assistance Booths are constructed across various locations in Haryana and Rajasthan; while for Education HIF established its first Institute of Driving Training and Research (IDTR) in Karnal, further, HIF also conducts awareness generation activities through its various SDECs and Traffic Training Parks.

Nearly 80% of road accidents are due to human error. Therefore, there is a need for right driving training and road safety education that can help in developing the right attitude towards safe driving and help in bringing down road accidents.

Towards this objective, **HIF established its first Institute of Driving Training and Research (IDTR) in Karnal in association with the state government of Haryana.** IDTR Karnal, is spread across an area of 9.25 acres and is equipped with state-of-the-art technology.

The **scientifically devised learner courses at IDTR have a combination of theory, simulator and practical training to facilitate wholistic learning experience for drivers** of four-wheelers, two-wheelers and Heavy Motor Vehicles. IDTR also covers training for existing drivers by conducting refresher courses.

Besides this the institute also offers special training programs to corporates and fleet owners.

The training at IDTR is focussed on understanding traffic regulations and safe driving habits. Further promoting this, HIF's experts will also provide training to participants on road safety and traffic rules & regulations. Other facilities at IDTR include **testing and training tracks for two-wheelers and four-wheelers, air-conditioned smart classrooms,** observation rooms, in-house workshop, computer lab and medical room.

This training facility is one step towards the direction of imparting quality driving skills and education and help create awareness and promote a culture of road safety in India.

This is the first IDTR to be equipped with **Automated Driving Testing Track** used to test the skills of driving license applicants through **up-gradient, forward-8, reverse-S and traffic junctions.** This minimizes human intervention and increases the efficiency of authorities in issuing driving licenses.

The institute will provide training to all types of drivers including **two-wheeler, four-wheeler and Heavy Motor Vehicles under one roof.**

Saving Lives Through Police Assistance Booths

According to World Bank, in the last decade 13 lakh people have died due to road accidents in India. While the lack of proper roads, rash and negligent driving can partly be blamed for this high number, a large portion of these deaths can be avoided with proper medical attention and first aid on time.

To this end, HIF collaborated with Haryana Police for **installation of 45 Police Assistance Booths on Highway No. 1, 2 and 8 in Haryana.**

These booths assist the police in providing first aid to accident victims and ensuring on time medical support. **12 Police Assistance Booths have also been set up on State Highway No. 25 connecting Bhiwadi to Alwar in Rajasthan.**

Further, first aid training sessions for the police were also conducted to develop their skills in providing medical support along with counselling on how to pacify and speak with accident victims.





Traffic Training Parks

Honda started its first traffic park in 2013 and has now adopted 10 traffic parks across India. These Traffic Training Parks are set up in partnership with local government or law enforcement authorities like municipal corporations, traffic police, transport department, etc. These traffic parks facilitate awareness generation on road safety to young children and adults. Besides this, the several events are also held on its premises. Brief outline of activities as per different age groups is provided below:

Some notable events held at Traffic Training Parks this year:

1. National Police Commemoration Day:

National Police Commemoration Day is observed every year on 21st October to honour the brave policemen of our country. This year, HIF organised exclusive road safety awareness sessions for police officials at Traffic Training Parks in Chennai and Coimbatore. More than 50 police officials participated in the program.
